MATERIAL HANDLER & METAL TRADES FABRICATOR AGREEMENT

ADDENDUM "K" TO THE UA LOCAL 290/PMCA MASTER LABOR AGREEMENT

This Material Handler & Metal Trades Fabricator Agreement – Addendum "K" by this reference is made a part of the UA Local 290/PMCA Master Labor Agreement, which is effective from April 1, 2017 to March 31, 2023. This Addendum "K" establishes the exceptions for Material Handler & metal Trades Fabricator work within the jurisdiction of UA Local 290 in Oregon and the applicable counties in Southwest Washington and Northern California as specified in the UA Local 290/PMCA Master Labor Agreement.

This Addendum will in no way encroach on the Scope of Work described in the UA Manufacturing Union Label Agreement or the National Minimum Standard Agreement for a Commercial Pipe Fabrication Shop or any other UA National Agreement. Any questions regarding jurisdiction shall be directed to the Business Manager of Local 290 and the Plumbing and Mechanical Contractors Association (PMCA).

Duration, Termination and Renewal of this Addendum "K" shall be as defined in Article XXI, Section 21.1 of the current UA Local 290/PMCA Master Labor Agreement.

Scope of Work:

Metal Trades classifications of employees may perform the following work assignments in and around the shop in connection with the making of pipe bends, the fabrication of piping, and fabrication of other miscellaneous products.

- 1. The loading, handling, or placing into stockpiles or bins the piping, valves, fittings, etc., which will be fabricated into assemblies or formations and the loading of piping and materials on railroad cars or trucks.
- 2. The handling of piping to and through any furnaces and the tamping or packing process for the making of bends.
- 3. The operation and swamping of all cranes, fork lift trucks, trucks and all other shop handling equipment.
- 4. Operation of all pre-heat and stress type furnaces or equipment.
- 5. Refacing of flanges or operations of a nature which must be performed on a drill press, lathe or boring mill.

- 6. The manufacture of any products other than those normally accepted as pipe bends, pipe formations, or welded pipe assemblies shall be considered as catalog items, i.e. Metal Trades work.
- 7. Cutting, beveling, threading, bending, and welding of pipe to be used for, but not limited to, such products as light stanchions, handrails, directional signs, flag poles, pipe supports, etc.
- 8. All cutting and beveling connected with pipe assembly performed by mechanical devices such as band saws and carbon saws.

 (Operation of torch or gas devices used for cutting and beveling connected with pipe assembly is Building Trades work.)
- 9. Grinding, cleaning, blasting, painting, marking of pipe, plugging ends, disassembling, assembling, and protecting valves, piping, etc.
- 10. Making and installing pipe and flange end protectors.
- 11. The operation of any equipment necessary to manufacture catalog articles.
- 12. Maintenance work.

Economic Package: See current wage sheet

Raise \$1.00 per hour per year until 60% of Commercial & Industrial Taxable + MOB

Note: Contribution increases for Local Pension, National Pension, and Training will be calculated on a proportional basis over the term of the Agreement. Other Benefit Plan Contributions will be as required by the Master Labor Agreement.
